ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
California Fly Fishermen Unlimited
A California Nonprofit Corporation

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of this corporation is: CALIFORNIA FLY
FISHERMEN UNLIMITED.

ARTICLE II - Purpose and Powers

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is:
 - 1. To educate anglers in the art of fishing with artificial flies and in the practices of sportsmanship and conservation.
 - 2. To conduct education activities to bring to the general public information on fly fishing and on conservation and improvement of fishery and water resources.
 - 3. To study and make recommendations on government fishery and resource policies which affect fly fishing quality and opportunities.
- C. The general purpose of this corporation is to have and exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of California.
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- E. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE III - Change of Status to Corporation

With the filing of these articles an existing, unincorporated association, CALIFORNIA FLY FISHERMEN UNLIMITED, is being incorporated.

ARTICLE IV - Members

Any person, association, firm, or corporation may become a member of this corporation upon such terms and conditions as contained in the By-Laws of this corporation.

ARTICLE V - Directors

The number of Directors of this corporation shall be fixed by resolution of the Directors but shall not be fewer than seven (7) nor more than eleven (11). The names and addresses of the Directors who shall act in that capacity until their successors are installed are as follows:

Upon dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts

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and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
